



Best Practices for Cleaning Your POS Device(s)



To help keep your point-of-sale (POS) device(s) hygienic during this time, please follow these easy **cleaning** and **disinfecting** tips:



Cleaning

POS devices should only be gently cleaned with water using a lightly damp microfiber cloth. Do not use solvents, detergents, or abrasive cleaners. Please refrain from vigorously shaking the terminal(s) to prevent triggering the tamper alert.



Disinfecting

After cleaning, the devices may be disinfected using an alcohol-based wipe or alcohol-based cleaner applied to a microfiber cloth. Do not spray, coat or pour any disinfectant or other liquid directly onto the device. Never use bleach, thinner, trichloroethylene, or ketone-based solvents – they can deteriorate plastic or rubber parts.
